Students already accepted who expect to receive full scholarships or full forms of financial aid, not contingent upon repayment, are asked not to apply.

Below is valuable information regarding this program:

- 1) You, the Applicant must be a member in good standing of **AFCU** to apply.
- 2) The maximum scholarship is \$500.00. Only those individuals who are registered or will be registering as a full-time student at an Accredited College/University need apply. Scholarship money will be paid to the Accredited College/University and is to be used for tuition and or books only.
- 3) Scholarship money received may be considered taxable income under the current IRS guidelines.

Students must complete the application form and submit the following information:

1. Official transcript with a cumulative GPA of 2.75 including SAT/ACT test results. Transcript must be initialed by a Counselor or someone within the Registrar’s Office.
2. A signed Letter of Recommendation from a high school teacher, counselor, college professor or administrator, community or church leader or any non- family member.
3. An essay of 650 typed words answering the following question: **Describe Why people should support the Credit Union Movement.**
4. List all extracurricular activities such as school activities, organizations, church, and volunteer work. Provide the name of the organization, the type of work and the time involved in the organization.
5. Copy of the Acceptance Letter from the Accredited College/University.
6. Provide a copy/list of any assistance you will be receiving from other sources
